TRANSFORMED BY GOD'S PROMISES -2

Here are some of the magnificent promises pertaining to the seven salvation points listed in my last article. I urge you to meditate on these verses diligently.

1&2. REDEMPTION AND FORGIVENESS OF SINS

a)"If we confess our sins, He is faithful and righteous to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness ... the blood of Jesus His (God's) Son cleanses us from all sin." (I John 1:9,7)

b)"In Him we have redemption through His blood, the forgiveness of our trespasses, according to the riches of His grace." (Ephesians 1:7)

c)"Much more then, having now been justified by His blood, we shall be saved from the wrath of God through Him." (Romans 5:9)

In all these three promises, forgiveness and redemption is through the blood of the Lord Jesus. God does not forgive because He thinks you are "good enough." No! God's desire is that all men everywhere should come to repentance, and to faith in Christ, so that He might gladly forgive them. It was not easy to provide redemption; it required the sacrifice of the Son, Jesus the Messiah, on the Cross of Calvary. Now, if God could pay that price, and if Jesus could pay that price, would He be unwilling to redeem all who call upon the Name of the Lord?

Contemplate on the depth of this promise:

"What then shall we say to these things? If God is for us, who is against us? He who did not spare His own Son, but delivered Him up for us all, how will He not also with Him freely give us all things?" (Romans 8:31-32)

And this, about being saved from judgment and eternal death:

"Truly, truly, I say to you, he who hears My Word, and believes Him who sent Me, has eternal life, and does not come into judgment, but has passed out of death into life." (John 5:24)

Understand the depth and unchangeable truth in these verses and make them yours.

3. THE NEW BIRTH

"Therefore if any man is in Christ, the Messiah, he is a new creature; the old things passed away, behold, new things have come." (2 Corinthians 5:17)

"Whoever believes that Jesus is the Messiah is born of God." (1 John 5:1)

4. RECEIVING THE MESSIAH

"But as many as received Him, to them He gave the right to become children of God, even to those who believe in His name, who were born not of blood, nor of the flesh, nor of the will of man, but of God." (John 1:12-13)

5. ETERNAL LIFE

"For God so loved the world, that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish, but have eternal life. He who believes in the Son has eternal life; but he who does not obey the Son shall not see life, but the wrath of God abides on Him." (John 3:16, 36)

"He has granted to us His precious and magnificent promises, in order that by them you might become partakers of the divine nature." (2 Peter 1:4)

Jesus said: "And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again, and receive you to Myself; that where I am, there you may be also." (John 14:3)

"For our citizenship is in heaven, from which also we eagerly wait for a Saviour, the Heavenly Master Jesus the Messiah; who will transform the body of our humble state into conformity with the body of His glory, by the exertion of the power that He has even to subject all things to Himself." (Philippians 3:20-21)

6. RECEIVING THE HOLY SPIRIT

"Now on the last day, the great day of the feast, Y'shua stood and cried out saying, "If any man is thirsty, let him come to Me and drink. He who believes in Me, as the Scripture said, 'From his innermost being shall flow rivers of living water'. But this He spoke of the Spirit, whom those who believed in Him were to receive." (John 7:37-39)

"You shall receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you." (Acts 1:8)

"Or do you not know that your body is a temple of the Holy Spirit who is in you, whom you have from God, and that you are not your own?" (1 Corinthians 6:19) "What shall we say to those things?" What shall we do with such magnificent promises? It is my earnest desire that you chew and digest all the verses given in this article; as you munch on them, let them into your blood stream.

"How shall we escape if we neglect so great a salvation?" (Hebrews 2:3)

Listen to God's reasoning with you:

In His wisdom, God gave married couples two basic instructions: Wives, submit to your husbands. Husbands, love your wife as you love yourself. (Ephesians 5)

The reason most people break out into a rash and can't get anything out of that text is because they get fixated on the word "submit" without understanding what it truly means.

By saying "submit", God is not suggesting that you ought to act like a slave. That's the devil trying to twist things up in your mind to keep you from seeing the light. What God is really suggesting is that you should love and reverence your husband to such a degree that anytime you want to go to the store and your husband says, "I think it's better we stay indoors", you should calm yourself down and say alright, "Let's stay home if that's what you

want to do... coz wherever you are that's where I want to be."

God also challenges the husband to love his wife such that anytime she wants to do something he is not too eager about, he should not get upset and beat his wife up emotionally... or physically. The men who do that don't really love themselves...and it shows in their attitude towards their spouse. If you want to know what a man thinks of himself all you have to do is observe how he treats his wife.

God wants us to understand that marriage is about love and sacrifice. Every time you crucify what you want to do and what you want to say on the cross and calm yourself down, you are making a sacrifice.

Every time you want to yell at your spouse and kids, but then you say: "No, I will NOT lose it today," you are making a sacrifice. And that sort of sacrifice is acceptable to God, for it rises up to Him like a sweet-smelling incense.




